House Helps Secure America's Energy Future

Washington – Joining the U.S. Senate, the House of Representatives has passed historic energy legislation that will begin to provide America with greater energy security, the tools to help mitigate the impacts of climate change, and a roadmap to rethinking how we produce and use energy in this country. The bill now heads to the president's desk where he has said he will sign it into law.

Renewable Fuels Association President Bob Dinneen praised the House's action, saying:

By coupling increased renewable fuels use with improved efficiency standards for automobiles, Congress is making a bold statement about the future direction of energy policy in this country.
